President's Message



Professional Development and Conference Management

During the summer of 2020, AAZK took the first steps to rebranding and relaunching our learning site, AAZK Online. This site was originally developed to connect members with professional resources and virtual courses on a variety of topics, in collaboration with the San Diego Zoo Global Academy. Access to the site is a membership benefit.

AAZK Online was refreshed by removing outdated information and adding a site navigation course, past conference proceedings and new personal professional resources. This was timely because of the pandemic and the effects on our members, and we wanted to offer resources that would support them during a time when they might unexpectedly need to update their CV or resume or look for new employment.

AAZK Online was rebranded to AAZK C.O.R.E. - Center for Online Resource Engagement. A marketing plan was developed to introduce this new platform to the membership via email, social media and the Animal Keeper's Forum. New courses were identified based on feedback from a membership survey and from current AAZK resource documents. AAZK C.O.R.E. will offer resources in three ways -
